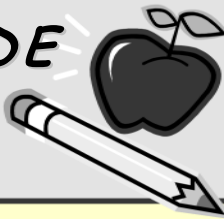

Science/Social Studies

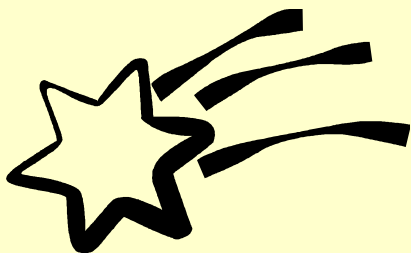
